A legal agreement with CJ Events be entered into regarding the ownership of the market stalls
Not having a legal agreement with CJ Events which would mean the Council may not have control over an asset which it has used public funds to procure
A legal agreement be entered into with CJ Events regarding the ownership of the market stalls.
The Council took over the running of the market in January 2023 from Rugby First who had been operating it on behalf of the Council for a number of years.
It used UK Shared Prosperity Fund to procure new market stalls and a trailer to transport them. This was to ensure that the market has an homogenous look and improved aesthetic.
CJ Events are employed by the Council to run the market. They are responsible for erecting and taking down the stalls on market day. They also store the stalls on their premises.
A legal agreement is required to ensure that if CJ Events no longer are employed to the Council then the stalls are returned.
