3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 7th May 2026.

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes, and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, and Evreux Way, Rugby CV21 2RR by 5pm on Tuesday, 21st April 2026. 6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday, 28th April 2026.
