Rugby Borough Council are committed to the safeguarding and wellbeing of all participants during our activities. All of our sports coaches and activity leaders are DBS checked and qualified.


All our activities are open to children with a disability, but please be aware our coaches and leaders have to supervise activities. Please make sure you provide appropriate personal care for your child if needed.
