Public Report of the Monitoring Officer

Recommendation

The appointment of Dan Green, Acting Chief Executive, as Returning Officer and Electoral Registration Officer for Rugby Borough Council., be approved.

1. Executive Summary

- 1.1. The role of both the Returning Officer and Electoral Registration Officer are statutory appointments that must be made by Full Council.
- 1.2. These positions have been held by the Monitoring Officer who will be leaving the Council in May. The proposed recommendation seeks to appoint the Acting Chief Executive to both positions with immediate effect.

2. Background

- 2.1. Following the recent announcement in respect of Local Government Reorganisation the County elections will now proceed in May 2025. Prior to such elections the Council will require an appointed Returning Officer who will act as the Deputy Returning Officer in the upcoming County election.
- 2.2. In addition, the Council's appointed Returning Officer is responsible for running all parish polls, neighbourhood plan referendums, local elections as well as national elections, and unscheduled elections/referendums can occur at any time.
- 2.3. s.35 of the Representation of the People Act 1983 requires the Council to appoint an officer of the Council to be Returning Officer who is the person with overall responsibility for the conduct of elections.
- 2.4. The Returning Officer is an officer of the Council, but the role is independent and separate from their duties as an employee of the Council. In discharging their duty, they have personal responsibility for the conduct of elections and are directly accountable to the High Court.
- 2.5. The Returning Officer may appoint one or more persons to act as Deputy Returning Officers to discharge any of his/her functions.
- 2.6. There is also a requirement for the Council to appoint an Electoral Registration Officer and this is set out within S.8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983. The Electoral Registration Officer has the responsibility to create and maintain the register of electors and list of absent voters. This person takes

responsibility for publishing a revised electoral register and issuing monthly alteration notices. Again, this is a personal responsibility, independent and separate from their duties as an employee of the Council.

3. Conclusion

3.1. The proposed recommendation seeks to make the required appointments to ensure the Council can discharge its statutory responsibilities as an electoral authority. This will ensure the required preparation can take place in respect of the upcoming scheduled county elections in May 2025.
