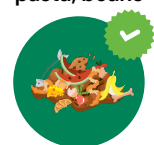

PLEASE KEEP RECYCLING LOOSE - EMPTY ALL BAGS
Loose recycling helps us to separate materials correctly. Bagged items don't get recycled



WHY KEEP BATTERIES OUT?
Batteries cause fires - keep out of all bins



WHAT HAPPENS TO MY WASTE?
Your recycling is sorted automatically and sent to UK recycling companies to be made into new products. Food is sent to a digester to make clean energy.

WASTE THAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED

Your **black** refuse bin is only for other materials that **cannot** be recycled, e.g. they are not accepted in the blue lid or green waste bin.
