I write on behalf of Kilsby Action Group who are a core group supported by a large number of residents and exist to protect the village and its rural setting and prevent it being “ swallowed up” by urban over development.

We wish to object to the site behind Crick Road and adjacent to Kilsby Lane being included in the final list of sites adopted by Rugby Borough Council in its new local plan . The rural amenity that Kilsby villagers share with Hillmorton residents and others who use Kilsby Lane is simply too lovely to be concreted over in the dash to satisfy some arbitrary number of houses that central government are demanding. Also, the potential to add large numbers of cars into Kilsby lane is both dangerous and damaging to the environment .
