I represented the Save Coventry Speedway & Stox Campaign Group (SCS) at the Public Inquiry at Coventry Stadium, Brandon which resulted in dismissal of proposals for housing redevelopment of the site (Appeal Ref: APP/E3715/W/23/3322013).

I have submitted a representation via SCS strongly supporting Policy W1B which supports the restoration of Coventry Stadium, Brandon for speedway and stock car racing and other motor sports together with other community uses.

However, I would like to see the local plan take a further step which would see the site of Coventry Stadium, Brandon designated as a sports facility on the Policies Map. I wish to register an objection to this effect.

Paragraph 7.2 lists Coventry Stadium, Brandon alongside other sports facilities. For consistency those other facilities should also be similarly protected. This modification to the local plan would ensure consistency with other policies that see protected areas already designated on the Policies Map. Open Space and Local Green Space are obvious examples.
