I am writing as a local supporter to ask you to continue supporting efforts to save and restore Coventry Speedway.

Firstly, I would like to thank the Council for previously denying housing development on this site. Introducing a large housing estate would inevitably bring significant additional pressures to Binley Woods, including increased traffic, strain on local infrastructure, and further challenges for an already close-knit community. Your decision was appreciated by many local residents.

Coventry Speedway is not just a disused track — it is a place of memories, heritage, and community pride. Generations of families have grown up attending meetings there. On a personal note, my grandad raced for the Coventry Bees at this very venue, and I know he would be over the moon to see it brought back to life and used for what it was meant for.

At present, the site is sadly a wasteland. Left unused, it attracts antisocial behaviour and unsafe curiosity from younger generations. This benefits no one. By contrast, restoring Coventry Speedway would transform the area into a positive, exciting, and well-managed space that brings people together rather than pushing them away.

Reopening the speedway would give families an affordable local activity, provide inspiration for young people, and bring life and excitement back into people's lives. Event nights would support nearby businesses, while the venue itself would once again become a source of joy, shared memories, and community connection.

Saving Coventry Speedway is a practical way to preserve local heritage while also creating a safer, more vibrant future for the area. I strongly encourage the Council to support solutions that return the site to active use and ensure it becomes a place for memories, excitement, and pride once again.
