As a cotton park resident who is already experiencing congestion and unsafe conditions on local roads, I am worried that the plans lack of transport modelling for major development in North Rugby. The plan does not assess the impact of Coton Park East, Newton manor lane, Rugby parkway station and the nearby village growth. The Newton manor lane is narrow, lacks pavement and is already risky and yet there are no commitments to any widening or pedestrian Safety initiatives. The plan has vague language instead of binding delivery and provides no HGV routing strategy which is a risk to the residential streets nearby. This plan is not justified until a full strategic transportation assessment is guaranteed to the area.
