② The GP surgery in Wolvey is limited to certain opening hours on certain days. At present we go to Bolkington surgery and considering Bolkington is undergoing a large development of houses where will the occupants of new homes go. Again will long journeys be required.

③ The public transport we presently have is very poor and not sufficient.

④ We have no hospital, dentist again requiring a journey to visit these places.
