The development is being built by a school. The access to that school right now is already extremely difficult. The developers are proposing to access the development on the main road past a primary school that isn't wide enough for two HGVs. The number of empty rental units by the school is ridiculous. To now build further units on

green land space used by the residents, in such proximity to homes and a primary school is appalling and makes me want to move. If this was your home and right next to where you lived you would feel the same. But for some reason the mass development of warehouses around our historical town is the focus.

If we can't stop this happening PLEASE ensure the safety of our children and do not allow access to be opened past the school and ask the developers to be clear about their "gift" or a parcel of land for a playing field. Think of your own children in this decision if you can't think of mine.
