Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Proposed Submission Local Plan. I'm writing to express my strong support for keeping Brandon Stadium protected for speedway and stock car racing under Policy W1B.

My family and I visited Brandon Stadium many times over the years. Some of our happiest memories were made there — sharing the excitement, the noise, the atmosphere, and the sense of community that the stadium created. It was one of those rare places where several generations could enjoy something together, and I would love future families to have those same opportunities.

The stadium's importance has been recognised repeatedly. Rugby Borough Council voted overwhelmingly to safeguard it within the emerging Local Plan, with Policy W1B backing its full restoration for motorsport use. The Planning Inspector has also confirmed that the stadium's national significance outweighs proposals for housing and that restoring it remains a viable option.

For my family — and for so many others — Brandon Stadium wasn't just a venue. It was part of our lives. Bringing it back would help recreate that family-friendly atmosphere and ensure that future generations can enjoy the same quality time and community spirit we experienced. I hope you will continue to protect and support the reinstatement of Brandon Stadium as part of this Local Plan.

Rugby Borough Council is updating its local plan. The local plan sets out policies and locations for new development across the borough, and we are obliged to review it every 5 years as a minimum.

The Proposed Submission Local Plan is the document the Council intends to submit to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government to be examined by an independent Planning Inspector. It sets out a development strategy for the Borough for the period 2025-2042, allocates land for development, and includes development management policies to be used for determining planning applications.

The document has been informed by feedback received during the two previous rounds of public consultation – the ‘Issues and Options’ consultation which concluded in February 2024, and the ‘Preferred Option’ consultation which concluded in May 2025.
