



COMMUNITY WARDEN SERVICE

Rugby Borough Council operates a Community Warden Service that supports town centre safety by addressing low level anti-social behaviour and environmental issues. Community Wardens provide reassurance patrols and engagement but do not replace the role of the Police or emergency services.

Wardens can help with:

- ✓ Low-level anti-social behaviour
- ✓ Noise, odour and light nuisance complaints
- ✓ Reporting and escalation for the removal of graffiti
- ✓ Fly tipping

Wardens cannot:

- ✗ Deal with crime, including shoplifting
- ✗ Investigate criminal offences
- ✗ Arrest or detain individuals
- ✗ Replace Police or other emergency services

Witnessed a crime or suspect a criminal offence?

Contact Warwickshire Police directly **101** in a non-emergency or **999** in an emergency. Community Wardens cannot investigate or respond to criminal matters.
