Reason	The demolition of the Perkins Grove Garages is required to enable the future development of the site as social housing. A specialist demolition contractor is required for health & safety reasons because the necessary specialist skills and experience are not available internally within the Council.
	Frank O'Gara & Sons Ltd have previously successfully demolished Bell House under the terms of the Efficiency East Midlands Demolition Framework and are currently on site undertaking the demolition of Biart Place. There are significant safety, logistical, operational and economic advantages to undertaking this work at the same time.
	The quotation provided is compliant with the Efficiency East Midlands Demolition Framework.
