## Strategic Land Availability Assessment 2014 'Call for Sites' Form

Rugby Borough Council is inviting developers, landowners and the wider public to put forward potential development sites as part of the Strategic Land Availability Assessment 'Call for Sites'. RBC is seeking land for both Housing development and Gypsy and Traveller sites.

This 'Call for Sites' will update information about all potential development sites – new and existing. If you have previously submitted a site we request you resubmit your site to ensure that we have the most up-to-date information. The Council will assume that existing sites are no longer available if you do not re-submit your site with up-to-date information.

Note: This study looks at land availability, but does not itself imply those sites will be allocated for development, or that planning applications will be considered favourably. Submitting details of a particular site does not guarantee that the Council will support or allocate the site for development.

Before completing this form, please read the following notes:

- ❖ All sections of this form MUST be completed. The Council will not follow up incomplete forms. Missing information is likely to result in your site being considered unavailable or unachievable and therefore lacking development potential.
- ❖ A separate form MUST be completed for each site (a photocopy is acceptable).
- ❖ You MUST include an Ordnance Survey based plan that includes the following:
  - A suitable scale to identify exact boundaries.
  - Location details for easy identification: grid references and field numbers are NOT sufficient. Two road names are usually appropriate.
  - The site clearly outlined in red.
  - Mark the type and location of any existing use(s) on the site.
- If you own more land/multiple sites then you must either:
  - Group sites to create one single large site, OR
  - Use a separate form and map for each site you wish to submit, OR
  - Highlight in BLUE any land that you DO NOT wish to promote for development, if it is situated adjacent to land that you DO wish to promote.


